CONSTRUCTION HEALTH AND SAFETY ON TEMPORARY OR MOBILE CONSTRUCTION SITES ACCORDING TO H.G. 300/2006

Construction Health and Safety co-ordination in the planning phase of the project:

Ensures the compliance with Construction Health and Safety procedures in the phases of study, concept and delivery of the project:

- › assists the planning of the project;
- › organizes and ensures co-operation between the designers in respect of construction health and safety risks;
- › co-ordinates the implementation of general Construction Health and Safety prevention principles regulated under Law no. 319/2006 and governmental decision (Romanian "Hotarare Guvernamentala", abbreviation "H.G.") H.G. 1425/2006, especially to liaise with the designers on choosing technical and/or organizational solutions for the purpose of planning different works or stages of works performed simultaneously or successively;
- › prepares The Construction Health and Safety Plan, issuing the applicable procedures, according to designated activities within the construction site;
- › prepares The Folder for Ulterior Interventions;
- › prepares and keeps up to date the Co-ordination Register;
- › emphasizes the general Construction Health and Safety requirements applicable to the construction site;
- › issues together with the Client, the preliminary declaration to the local inspectorate of labor (Romanian "Inspectoratul Teritorial de Munca", abbreviation "ITM") informing about the start of the works;
- › represents the Client in his relation with the Territorial Labor Inspectorates.

Construction Health and Safety co-ordination during the execution phase:

- › coordinates the implementation of necessary measures in order to ensure that employers and, whether the case might be, self-employed persons comply with the Construction Health and Safety principles in a coherent and responsible manner and that they apply the construction site's Health and Safety Plan;
- › keeps up to date the Health and Safety Plan and The Folder for Ulterior Interventions in accordance with the progress of the construction activities and with eventual changes that occur on the site;
- › co-ordinates the implementation of general prevention and safety principles, regulated under Law no. 319/2006 and H.G. 1425/2006, by all contractors and subcontractors from the site;
- › organizes the cooperation between contractors and their alternates and co-ordinates their activities regarding the safety of workers, accident and occupational illness prevention, coaching and mentoring the contractors a/o the self-employed on the construction health and safety requirements;
- › co-ordinates the activities that ensures the correct implementation of the Construction Health and Safety measures;
- › assesses all activity interferences within and in vicinity of the construction site;
- › establishes duties regarding the use of collective protective devices, the use of lifting devices, the access to the construction site;
- › visits the construction site together with each of the contractors or subcontractors before those start drawing up their own Construction Health and Safety Plan;
- › approves Construction Health and Safety Plans drawn up by contractors and agrees on necessary changes;
- › co-ordinates the implementation of the minimum Construction Health and Safety requirements, regulated under H.G. 1091/2006, H.G. 971/2006, H.G. 1146/2006, H.G. 1051/2006 and H.G. 1048/2006, by all contractors and subcontractors from the site.

Construction Health and Safety co-ordination during ulterior interventions:

- › coordinates the implementation of the general Construction Health and Safety requirements during ulterior interventions;
- › keeps up to date The Construction Health and Safety Plan and the The Folder for Ulterior Interventions in accordance with the progress of the construction activities and with eventual changes that occur on the site;
- › organizes the cooperation between employers and co-ordinates their activities with regard to safety of workers, accident and occupational illness prevention.
